NOMAD encourages club members to serve on committees, volunteer at trials and volunteer at any club events. The following descriptions should help you choose committees of interest.

COMMITTEES

Equipment Committee: Committee members keep track of and maintains the equipment. Suggests and makes recommendations for new equipment purchases. Assures that equipment is trial-ready and delivered to required locations.

Demo Committee: Committee members creatively identify locations and organize demonstrations of agility for public education. As a non-profit organization, it is our club's objective to educate the public and promote humane treatment and training of dogs.

Membership Committee: Committee members welcome new members to the club by handling applications, collecting dues, sending dues monies to the treasurer, keeping a record of members information, the member's chosen committees, sending member contact info to committee chairs and sending a welcome email to the club members. Sending club information to new members. Develops initiatives to keep the membership application and renewal process streamlined. Meets when necessary. Most issues and discussions are handled through email.

Seminar Committee: Committee members plans seminars, workshops and/or camps. The objective is to bring high level instructors to Vermont to present seminars. Seminars are for all club members. The committee has 3-4 meetings a year and will also plan via e-mail and/or virtual meetings. This committee includes a lot of pre-seminar planning and also requires responsibilities during the actual seminar (refreshments, setting courses, instructor hospitality, etc.).

Trial Committees: Committee members assist in all planning and organization of the trial committee joined (CPE, UKI and/or USDAA). Committee members assist in the format of the trial and plan, coordinate all logistics and aspects of the trial (premium creation, registration, site preparation, equipment, judges, volunteer workers, hospitality and more!). There are many big and small jobs to be done. Your participation and help would be appreciated at any or all of these events.
